


1. Log into your Godaddy account.

Under Hosting & Services select My Hosting Account.



2. Check the box next to the domain name you are setting up the database for and click the open link.



3. Select Databases click on Access



4. Click the Enable Access Support link.



5. Allow time for the server to setup the folder with correct permissions this can take upto 30 minutes. When Access support has been enabled the it should look like the image below. Logout of your godaddy account.

6. Look for the folder on your server with your FTP program, you should now see a folder named access_db
7. Once you see the directory you just created, then download it using your FTP program. Then open your fpdb folder (supplied with your template) and put the vsproducts.mdb in the directory folder you just downloaded.
8. Now upload that folder with the vsproducts.mdb in it to your server.
